IT'S TIME FOR CONGRESS TO GET SERIOUS ABOUT **NUCLEAR DISARMAMENT**

The only sure way to prevent nuclear war is to rid the world of nuclear weapons. This goal is both possible and practicable if we the people demand it and join a growing global chorus working to confront this existential threat to humanity.

In the U.S., preventing nuclear war starts with our members of Congress whose voices and votes help shape U.S. nuclear weapons policies and the decisions of the Executive Branch.

H. Res. 77 is a resolution that calls on the U.S. to embrace the goals and provisions of the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (TPNW), and to adopt Back from the Brink's common sense policies for preventing nuclear war.

What's the TPNW? The TPNW is the first legally binding international agreement by the United Nations to comprehensively prohibit nuclear weapons with the ultimate goal being their total elimination. It was opened for signature in 2017 and entered into force in January 2021.
