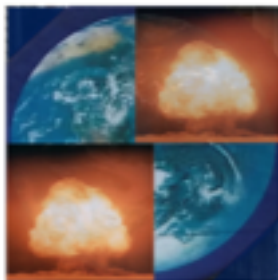


Tragedy of the Nuclear Age: July 16, 1945 to Now
